WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO

MISSION STATEMENT:

The mission of the Hartbauer/McBride Memorial Foundation (HMMF), Inc. as a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit, private corporation is to provide financial assistance to bikers in need. Our definition of a "Biker" is a licensed owner of a "street legal motorcycle." To receive assistance, the applicant's financial situation must be a "true hardship" arising from any type of emergency, be it accident, illness or catastrophic loss such as flood or fire. Every case is carefully evaluated to determine if it meets the Foundation's guidelines to receive assistance. In some cases, family members of the qualifying biker may be included.

The Foundation is not an insurance company, does not pay death benefit or supplement unemployment. The Hartbauer/McBride Memorial Foundation, Inc. provides limited assistance on a case-by-case basis and is not an alternative for taking personal responsibility for your own actions or paying your own bills when you can. The Hartbauer/McBride Memorial Foundation, Inc. is simply "a helping hand in a time of need." When every little bit helps!

The Foundation, made up of a Chairman, Officers, Liaisons and Representatives are all unpaid volunteers who perform their duties out of their love of motorcycles, those who ride, and the lifestyle of the "Biker"; hence the name: "Bikers Helping Bikers."

The goal is to be the first assistance a Biker In Need receives.
