Every case is carefully evaluated to determine if it meets the Foundation's guidelines to receive assistance. In some cases, family members of the qualifying biker may be included.

The Foundation is not an insurance company, does not pay death benefit or supplement unemployment. The Hartbauer/McBride Memorial Foundation, Inc. provides limited assistance on a case-by-case basis and is not an alternative for taking personal responsibility for your own actions or paying your own bills when you can. The Hartbauer/McBride Memorial Foundation, Inc. is simply "a helping hand in a time of need." When every little bit helps!

The Foundation, made up of a Chairman, Officers, Liaisons and Representatives are all unpaid volunteers who perform their duties out of their love of motorcycles, those who ride, and the lifestyle of the "Biker"; hence the name: "Bikers Helping Bikers."

The goal is to be the first assistance a Biker In Need receives.

"The Biker Fund" ...

is still dedicated to the belief and practice of "Bikers Helping Bikers" in a time of need. Organized before his death in 1987, Tom Hartbauer had the idea of providing a helping hand to our brothers and sisters in a time of need.

In 1997, the Biker Fund was incorporated in Missouri under the name Hartbauer/ McBride Memorial Foundation, Inc. as a private foundation with the sole purpose of providing assistance for all road-riding motorcyclists in a time of true need and hardship.

The Foundation is controlled by a Board of Directors. When an assistance request is received, the Chairman reviews the info provided under the guidelines of the form. The Chairman may need more details to determine true hardship and of what degree (State law as a notfor-profit requires this of us). The Board then votes to grant the request or not, and if so, states the dollar amount they feel is appropriate. If the request is granted, a check is cut in the amount agreed upon.

To quality for assistance, you must be a biker or, in some cases, an immediate family member. The situation must qualify as a true and honest hardship. The requester must live within 100 miles of the St. Louis Arch. Our guidelines are this: the Foundation is not a charity or insurance company or a hand out; the Foundation cannot eliminate all suffering, and it is not an alternative to taking responsibility for your own actions or paying your own bills when you can.
